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# ABOUT THE OCI FOUNDATION

- The **OCI Foundation** is:
  - An international organisation registered in Nigeria (2016) and Australian (2018)
  - A charity, Not-for-profit and Non-governmental organisation
  - Formally established for (Nigerians) to:
    - 1) **Promote and Advance Health**
    - 2) **Promote Education, and**
    - 3) **Promote Social and Public Welfare.**
- Its **ArOY Health Campaign** is its flagship **HEALTH INITIATIVE**:
  - Designed with the help of the **Harvard Medical School (USA)**
  - Has the support of the **World Health Organisation Country Office in Nigeria**
  - Developed with help of experts from 4 different universities, including:
    - **The Griffith University (Australia)**
    - **The Universities of British Columbia and Saskatchewan**
      - **Both in Canada; and**
    - **The Nnamdi Azikiwe University (Nigeria)**



# OVERVIEW

- The **OCI Foundation's ArOY Health campaign** **AIMS TO**
- Introduce anti-breast and anti-cervical cancer teachings into:
  1. Into the curriculum of all senior secondary schools in Nigeria
  2. The regular orientation activities of all 36 NYSC camps in Nigeria + FCT
- As ways of fighting both breast and cervical cancers
- Using novel, evidence-based measures that are:
  - Realistic
  - Cost-effective
  - Effective
  - Wide-reaching
  - Culturally acceptable, and
  - Sustainable.



# MONITORING SCHOOLS

- To guarantee the success of the program, NEEDS INCLUDE:
  - Monitoring of concerned teachers
  - Monitoring of concerned senior secondary schools
  - Across the 36 states of Nigeria and the FCT
- **States Education Ministries can establish their own monitoring teams; OR**
- **The National Orientation Agency (NOA) to assist**
  - The NOA has MOU with the OCI Foundation
    - The NOA assists with monitoring
    - The OCI provides training for the NOA staff; Plus technical support
    - The states assist with logistics support (as needed)
  - Monitoring is ongoing and permanent

# COURSE STRUCTURE

- Course is designed to allow monitors undergo the required training:
  - With ease
  - Monitors can be education ministry staff and/or the NOA staff
- The course is 100% free
- A certificate will be issued (free of charge) if:
  - All the modules are completed, and
  - The minimum pass scores for the accompanying quizzes are attained.
- Each Module has accompanying lessons, videos and quizzes
  - The videos contain same information as the lesson texts (use either, or both)
- At the end of the **TWO MODULES**, is a **FINAL QUIZ**. These are:
  - **MODULE 1:** Introduction and Background for State Program Monitors
  - **MODULE 2:** Monitoring techniques and Approaches
  - **FINAL QUIZ:** compulsory before receiving a certificate
