# Charity programs and activities

## Operations

**Did your charity operate in the 2025 reporting period? Yes**

### **Description of how your charity's programs helped achieve your purpose:**

#### 1) ON HEALTH

- The OCI Foundation continued to maintain its partnership with one of Africa's largest youth organisations, the Nigerian National Youth Service Corps (NYSC). Through this partnership, we delivered another six editions of our signature health program, the Arm Our Youths (ArOY) Anti-cancer Health Campaign. This brings the total to 23 completed editions since the partnership began in February 2022. The ArOY Health Campaign reaches over half a million youths each year (over the past 4 years) through life-saving and inspirational talks and activities.

- Since 2019, the ArOY Health Campaign has also been successfully integrated into the curriculum of all the 264 senior secondary schools in Anambra State, Nigeria (one of the country's 36 states). The program, now in its seventh year, has, in the process alone, reached additional hundreds of thousands (if not millions) of young Nigerian teenagers.

- The ArOY Health Campaign also has an additional component: the CerviBreast Mobile Phone Application, an innovative and interactive anti-cancer App that is freely available on the Google and Android Play stores. It is a life-saver, a global-first, and a multi-award-winning technological initiative of the OCI Foundation.

- There is also the "ArOY Health Campaign Schools Challenge (AHCSC)", a quiz contest designed to enhance engagement with the ArOY Health Campaign among senior secondary schools in Anambra State, Nigeria. This competition involves all the 264 public senior secondary schools in the State, with the Grand Finale held yearly on February 4th, World Cancer Day. The Grand Finale for the 4th (2024/25) Edition was successfully held in February 2025.

#### 2) ON EDUCATION

The OCI Foundation's annual scholarships added an 8th tier. The Foundation's scholarship scheme is uniquely designed, given that about five of them are primarily



interlinked, with the potential for a recipient to progress through its various levels from junior to senior secondary schools, and then through to the completion of their tertiary studies.

### 3) PUBLIC AND SOCIAL WELFARE

This is the third and final footing of the OCI Foundation's activity tripod. Among other things, it targets the disadvantaged population not enrolled in formal educational programs.

In 2025, not much progress was made on our quest to implement the two legislative bills initiated by the OCI Foundation through the Nigerian National Assembly over the past one to two years. Changes in Government slowed down the processes. We are still working on this.

We continued to work with the Girl Child Ambassador appointed a year or so earlier, in an attempt to bridge the gender divide in Northern Nigeria, particularly as it relates to the Boko Haram insurgency.

This part of the OCI Foundation's activities also allows us to continue sponsoring several social activities across multiple locations in Nigeria, including a soccer outfit and empowerment programs that train beneficiaries in various skills.
