FRAMEWORK FOR INITIATING SYSTEMIC CHANGES (March 2025)

Background

The OCI Foundation believes that effectively tackling issues relies on having a thorough understanding of the root causes of the problem. As such, we always aim to identify and target the root causes. Our initiatives aim to address holistically a range of structural, social, cultural, and other causes of poverty and inequality, as they relate to health, education, and social or public welfare.

Commitments:

1. Research is a key component of what we do, and, where possible, evaluations accompany all our initiatives at some point.
2. We also continually monitor public opinions, economic reports, and health data. These provide insights into issues of relevance and their root causes. They guide our ultimate initiatives.
3. Our programs consistently target those at the greatest risk. Our educational scholarships and health campaigns are designed in accordance with these.
4. Stakeholder engagement ahead of program rollout is a key component of our activities. This helps us address poverty, inequity and other health, educational or social issues.
5. As stated, we constantly evaluate our programs to assess the impact and efficacy of our initiatives while seeking areas for improvement. The OCI Foundation has a dedicated research unit that oversees this.
6. Our research encompasses direct, both qualitative and quantitative, engagements with partners, stakeholders, and beneficiaries. These are done routinely for all initiatives, whenever feasible.

Review of Framework

This policy is subject to review in March 2028, three years after its implementation. This can be sooner if legislation or other events warrant so.
